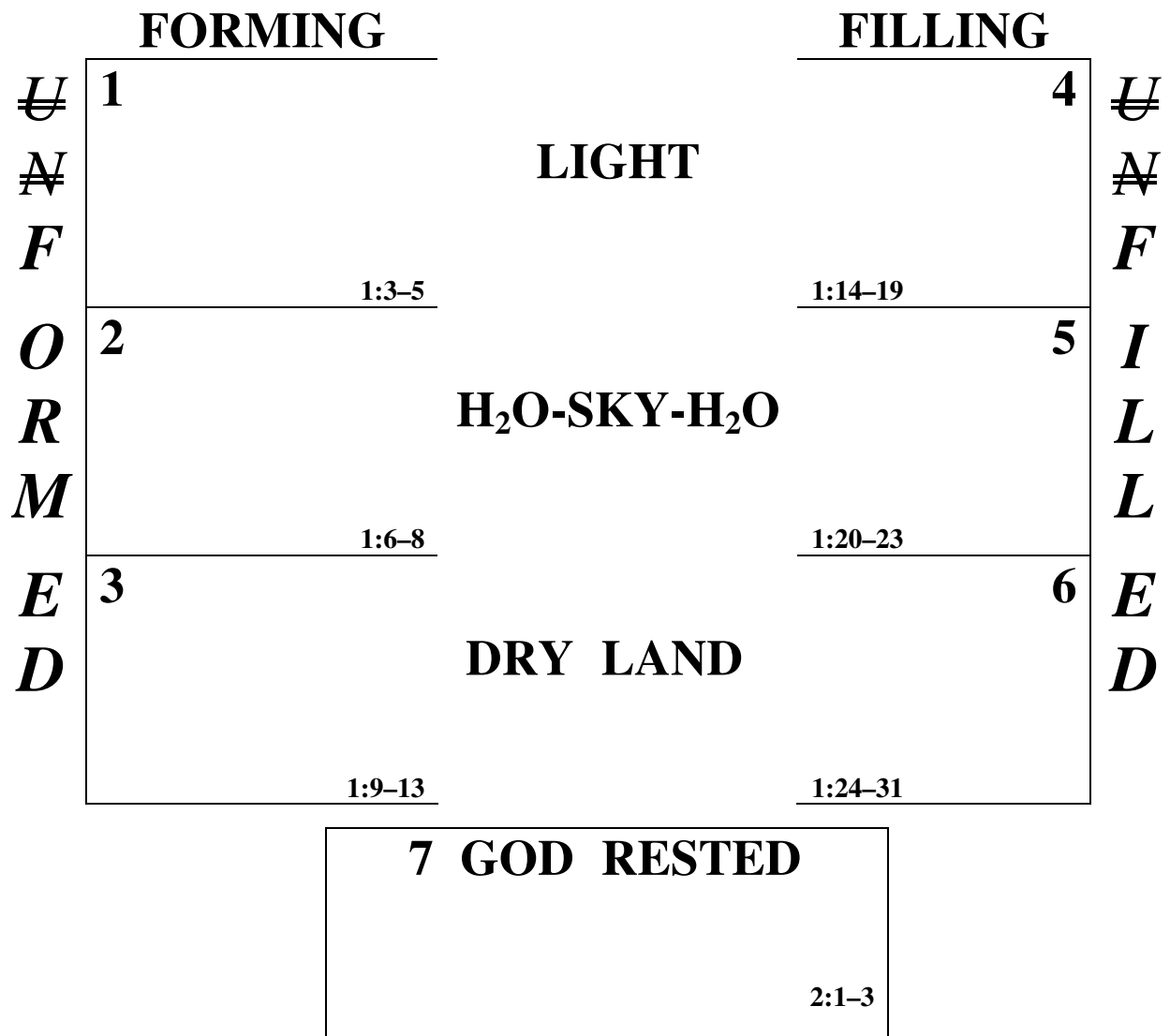

Genesis 1:2 The earth was **formless** and **void**



The significance of God resting on the seventh is that _____

Question: Did the earth actually become FULL of both light and life in days 4–6?

If life did not fill the earth by the sixth day, was creation actually complete on the sixth day?

GENESS 2:4ff.: A CLOSER LOOK AT THE SIXTH DAY

How do we know that Genesis 2:4ff. considers day 6 a second time?

Why (early in the day) did God say that, “Not good that man should be alone”?

The tree of life and the tree of the knowledge of good (life) and evil (death)

GENESS 3: THE FALL

Dying they would die when they ate of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil

Living they would live, if they had eaten of the tree of life

The man and the woman lost something when they ate of the wrong tree

The something that they lost was something that could be lost

Everlasting life cannot be lost, so they did not lose everlasting life

They lost life when they ate, but they did not yet have everlasting life
