(Continuation) God Set forth Jesus as a NT Mercy Seat by His blood through faith to prove His righteousness in passing over prior sins (3:25)
Jesus became a NT Mercy Seat to prove that God (in righteousness) passed over prior sins
God Set forth Jesus as a NT Mercy Seat to Prove His Present Righteousness: that He is both Just and the Justifier of Believers (3:26)
