Introduction

## Orientation to the Night's Geography (April 2, AD 33)


"I know those whom I chose, but so the Scripture may be fulfilled: «The one who eats bread with Me has raised his heel against Me.» From now on I tell you• before something happens, so when it happens, you• may believe that I am." (13:18b-19)

33 "Little children, I am with you• a little while. You• will seek Me, and as I told Judeans, 'Where I am going you• cannot come,' so now I tell you•." (13:33)

36 Simon Peter said to Him, "Lord, where are You going?" Jesus answered him, "Where I am going you cannot follow Me now; but later you will follow Me." (13:36)
"Let not your• heart be troubled. Believe• in God, believe• also in Me. In My Father's house are many abodes. Now, if it were not so, I would have told you•. I go to prepare a place for you $\bullet$. And if I go and prepare a place for you $\bullet$, I am coming again and will receive you $\bullet$ to Myself, so where I am you• also may be. And you $\bullet$ know where I am going and you $\bullet$ know the way." (14:1-4)
"Also I will ask the Father, and He will give you• another Advocate, the Spirit of truth, so He may abide with you $\bullet$ forever... I will not leave you• as orphans. I am coming to you $\bullet$. In a little while the world no longer sees Me, but you• will see Me. Because I live, you• will also live." (14:16, 18-19)
"So I have told you• now (before it happens), so when it may happen, you• would believe." (14:29)
"Remember the word that I told you•: 'A servant is not greater than his master.' If they persecuted Me, they will also persecute you $\bullet$. If they kept My word, they will also keep yours•. Instead, they will do all these things to you • because of My name, because they do not know the One who sent Me." (15:20-21)
"A little while and you • will not see Me; and again a little while and you $\bullet$ will see Me, because I go to the Father... Amen, amen, I tell you•, you• will weep and lament, but the world will rejoice and you• will be grieved, but your• grief will become joy." $(16: 16,20)$
"I did come forth from the Father and I have come into the world. Again, I am leaving the world and going to the Father... See, an hour is coming, and has now come, that you $\bullet$ will be scattered- each to his own home, and you• will leave Me alone. Yet I am not alone, for the Father is with Me." $(16: 28,32)$
"I have glorified You on the earth. I have completed the work You have given Me to do. And now, Father, glorify Me - along with Yourself- with the glory which I had along with You before the world was." (17:4f)
"Now I am no longer in the world, but these are in the world, and I am coming to You... But now I am coming to You, and I speak these things in the world so they may have My joy fulfilled in them." (17:11a, 13)
